WARRANTY INFORMATION:



While installation of these components will not "void" your vehicle's warranty, specific failures adjudged by Yamaha to have resulted from the installation of accessory components or other modifications, or from competition use, may not be covered by warranty or Yamaha Extended Service.



PREPARATION:

- 1. Place motorcycle on a secure stand.
- Be sure the fuel tank is free from any dust or other contaminants before applying the pad. Wax or polishes may not allow the pad to adhere properly. It is recommended to clean the mounting area with isopropyl alcohol before applying the pad.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Peel back a small section of plastic backing from the bottom edge of the tank pad ① (Fig.1a).
- Place the bottom edge of the tank pad on fuel tank. Use light pressure to adhere pad in place (Fig. 1).
- 3. Bring the tank pad into position on tank and adjust to the desired location.

NOTE: -

Choose location carefully as the part may be damaged if repositioning is required.

- 4. Once satisfied with location on the tank, peel off the remaining plastic backing and press tank pad into place.
- 5. Apply pressure up and out towards the edges in order to avoid air bubble formation.

CARE AND CLEANING:

Wash using a mild soap and water solution and a soft cloth. Avoid harsh cleaners or solvents.
