






PREPARATION:

- Stand motorcycle on a secure and level surface.
- Clean all mounting surfaces before beginning installation.

INSTALLATION:

- Insert ignition key into seat lock and turn clockwise. See Fig. 1. Lift stock passenger seat and set the passenger seat aside.
- Push the rider seat lock lever, located under the back of the rider seat and under the seat support, to open the latch and lift off the riders seat. See Fig. 2



- Remove the trim assembly from the center of the stock passenger seat. The assembly is two screws, two washers, and the trim piece. See Fig.3
- Install the trim assembly to the ② Comfort Passenger Seat and torque the two screws to 5Nm. See Fig. 3.
- Install the ① Rider comfort seat and press to lock the seat in place. Install the ② Passenger Comfort Seat and press to lock it in place. See Fig.4.

MAINTENANCE:

Periodically, check that the seat is locked in place. If loose – check alignment and press to lock in place.


CARE AND CLEANING:


Clean seat with a clean soft cloth and mild soap and water. Rinse and dry.
