



PREPARATION:


- 1. Place motorcycle on a secure and level surface.
- 2. Clean all mounting surfaces before beginning installation.
- 3. Place the motorcycle on a rear stand or the main stand before proceeding with the installation.

AWARNING


Failure to secure the motorcycle properly may result in possible injury to yourself or damage to the accessory or vehicle.

INSTALLATION:

1. Remove the stock glide plate. Retain all hardware shown in Figure 1 as it will be reused.



- 2. Install the original collars and grommets onto the glide plate ① as shown in Figure 2.
- 3. Install the plastic bumper ② onto the glide plate ① as shown in Figure 2.
- 4. Install the supplied collar ④ and grommet ③ onto the glide plate as shown in Figure 2.



NOTE:



Apply Loctite[®] 242 to the flange head bolt ⑤ and the threaded inserts on the engine block (Fig. 3).

- 5. Install the glide plate ① onto the studs on the engine case and use the original acorn nuts to secure in place (Fig. 3).
- 6. Torque the acorn nuts to 5 Nm (3.7 ft lb).
- 7. Secure the lower mounting location using the flange head bolt (5) and the washer (6) (Fig. 3).
- 8. Torque the flange head bolts (5) to 5 Nm (3.7 ft lb)

MAINTENANCE:

Periodically, check torque on all hardware. If loose hardware is found, remove hardware, clean off old Loctite[®], re-apply fresh Loctite[®], and re-torque to specification.

CARE AND CLEANING:

Wash using mild soap and water.
