



## PREPARATION:


- Place the vehicle on a secure and level surface.
   Set the parking brake.
- Clean the mount surfaces before beginning installation.

# **INSTALLATION:**

- Starting on the left side, remove front pillar guard and retain all hardware for reuse. There are two bolts. (Fig. 1)
- 2. Remove front mudguards, there are four bolts and two plastic rivets. Retain the hardware for reuse. (Fig. 2)
- 3. Remove the stock plastic plug from the rear of the lower frame tube. (Fig. 3)







- 4. Install the Plugs into the opening that had been covered by the plastic plug. Thread in a 7 M8x25mm Hex Socket Bolt from below through the frame and into the threads in the 5 Plug. See Fig. 4. Torque the bolt to 25 Nm (19 lb-ft).
- Just in front of the rear wheel, hold the ①
  Rock Slider, Left up to the rocker tube and thread 2 ⑥ M8x25mm Bolts through the
  ① Rock Slider and into the ⑤ Plug as shown in Fig. 4. Leave the bolts loose.
- Just behind the front wheel, hold the 4
   Nut plate against the tab in back and the 1
   Rock Slider in front. Place and pass 2
   3 M10x25mm Bolts through the bolt holes in the frame tab and thread them into the weld nuts on the 4 Weld Nut Plate as shown in Fig. 5 and Fig. 6.
- 7. Torque the 2 M10x25mm bolts to 50 Nm (37 ft-lbf) and the 2 M8x25mm bolts to 25Nm (19 lb-ft).
- 8. Repeat steps 1 through 7 on the right side.
- Install the Front Mudguards and Front Pilar Guards removed in steps 1-3. Refer to the Service Manual for torque settings on these parts.

#### **MAINTENANCE:**

Periodically, check torque on all hardware. If loose hardware is found, re-torque to specification.

#### **CARE AND CLEANING:**

Clean painted metal parts with a clean soft cloth and mild soap and water solution. Rinse and dry.
