This installation requires a torque wrench and should be performed by an authorized Yamaha dealer or other qualified technician.

PREPARATION:

- Place the vehicle on a secure and level surface.
- Set the parking brake and clean the mount surfaces before starting installation.

INSTALLATION:

TIP: Have an assistant help hold the plates in place while installing bolts.

- Start in the front of the vehicle, remove the 4 bolts that secure the stock front skid plate (Fig. 1). Remove the front skid plate. The bolts will not be used in this installation.
- Fit up the front skid plate ① to the frame. Note positions of the 4 threaded holes on the frame and the two square spaces to the rear. Install two U-nuts to these square spaces as shown in Fig. 3 and Fig. 4.

TIPS: The threaded part of the U-nut is always 'inside' the frame. The hole in the U-nut aligns with the hole in the frame, as shown in Fig.3.

- 3. Use 6 Hex Bolts w/Washers ② to attach the Front Skid Plate ① to the 4 threaded holes in the front and the 2 rear U-nuts ③. Leave these hand tight (Fig. 2).
- Adjust the position of the skid plate to your preference. When you are satisfied with the fit, torque the bolts to 8.5 Nm (0.85 m-kgf, 6.0 ft-lbf).

MAINTENANCE:

Periodically, check torque and tightness on hardware. If found loose, re-torque or re-tighten.

CARE AND CLEANING:

Clean metal parts with a clean soft cloth and mild soap and water. Rinse and dry.
