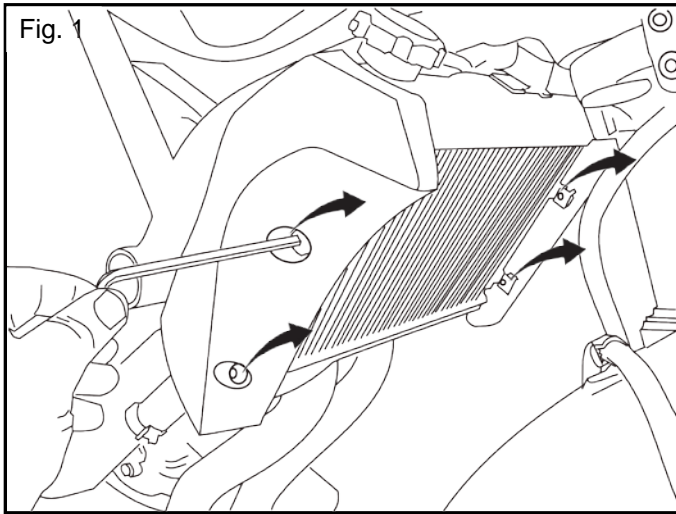
This installation requires a torque wrench and should be performed by an authorized Yamaha dealer or other qualified technician.

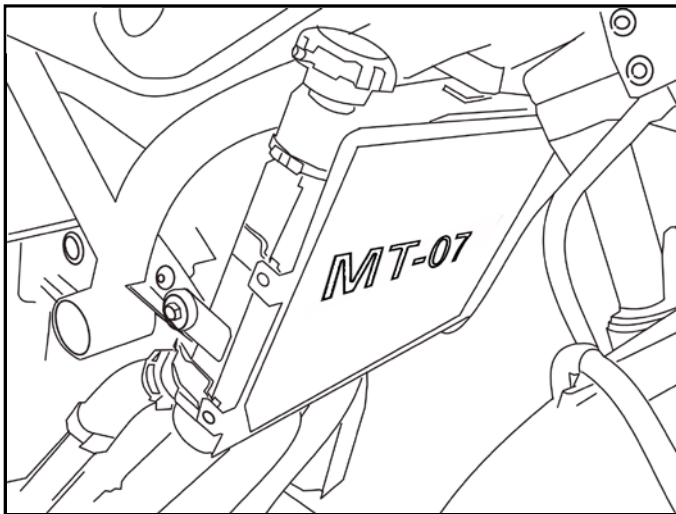


PREPARATION:

- Stand motorcycle on a secure and level surface.
- Clean mounting surfaces before installation.
- The engine and radiator should be cool to the touch.

INSTALLATION:

1. Remove the stock radiator side covers and retain all bolts and the side covers (Fig.1).
2. Locate the radiator guard on the side cover mounts using the stock bolt holes (Fig. 2).
3. Re-install the stock radiator side covers, over the new radiator guard, using the stock bolts. The bolts pass through the mount brackets on the radiator guard (Fig. 3).
4. Torque 4 mount bolts to 7 Nm (0.7 m-kgf, 5.1 ft-lbf).



MAINTENANCE:

Periodically check the bolts and retorque as needed.

CARE AND CLEANING:

Wash using a mild soap and water solution and soft cloth.
