





#### PREPARATION:

- Stand motorcycle on a secure and level surface.
- Clean mounting surfaces before installation.
- The engine and radiator should be cool to the touch.

## **INSTALLATION:**

- 1. Remove the stock radiator side covers and retain all bolts and the side covers (Fig.1).
- 2. Locate the radiator guard on the side cover mounts using the stock bolt holes (Fig. 2).
- 3. Re-install the stock radiator side covers, over the new radiator guard, using the stock bolts. The bolts pass through the mount brackets on the radiator guard (Fig. 3).
- 4. Torque 4 mount bolts to 7 Nm (0.7 m-kgf, 5.1 ft-lbf).

#### **MAINTENANCE:**

Periodically check the bolts and retorque as needed.

#### **CARE AND CLEANING:**

Wash using a mild soap and water solution and soft cloth.
