IMPORTANT: YZ models are for closed-course competition only regardless of modification. YZ models do not meet federal or state emission standards for recreational off-road use.


NOTICE:

WARRANTY INFORMATION:





PREPARATION:

- 1. Stand the motorcycle on a secure and level surface.
- 2. Clean all mounting surfaces before beginning installation.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Remove the stock clutch cover referencing the Yamaha Owner's Service Manual. Retain all hardware as it will be reused.
- Reference the Yamaha Owner's Service Manual to Install the GYTR Clutch Cover ① and gasket ② using the stock hardware. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Reinstall the oil check bolt. Torque the bolt to to 10 Nm (1.0 m kgf, 7.2 ft lbf). (Fig. 2)
- 4. Torque clutch cover bolts to 10 Nm (1.0 m kgf, 7.2 ft lbf).

TIP: Tighten the clutch cover bolts in stages, using a crisscross pattern

MAINTENANCE:

Periodically check all clutch cover bolts for tightness and re-torque as necessary.

CARE AND CLEANING:

Wash using a mild soap and water solution and soft cloth.
