



PREPARATION:

- Stand the motorcycle on a secure and level surface.
- Drain the oil from the engine.
- Alternately, lean the motorcycle on its left side, and ensure that any oil lost during installation is replaced.
- Clean all mounting surfaces before beginning installation.

INSTALLATION:

- Remove the stock clutch cover referencing the Yamaha Owner's Service Manual. Retain all hardware as it will be reused.
- 2. Install the GYTR Clutch Cover ① and gasket ② using the stock hardware. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Torque clutch cover bolts to 10 Nm (1.0 m-kgf, 7.2 ft-lbf).

TIP: Tighten the clutch cover bolts in stages, using a crisscross pattern.

MAINTENANCE:

Periodically check all clutch cover bolts for tightness and retorque as necessary.

CARE AND CLEANING:

Wash the exterior of the clutch cover with a mild soap and water solution and soft cloth.
