PREPARATION:

- 1. Place vehicle on a secure and level surface.
- 2. Set the parking brake.
- 3. Clean all mounting surfaces before installation.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Start on the left front.
- 2. Position the left front overfender ① to align front and rear with the stock fender.
- 3. Use the bolt holes on the overfender to mark bolt hole locations on the stock fender.

TIP: Hold the overfender in place with blue painter's tape or have it held by an assistant.

 Use a 1/4" drill bit to drill through the stock fender in the eight overfender mount locations (Fig. 1).

TIP: Drill one hole first, install a bolt assembly (steps 5 and 6), and then move on to the next. Align and adjust the overfender as you go.

- Start on the horizontal seam. Place a washer
 on a longer bolt 6 and insert the bolt through the overfender. Place a spacer 5 on the bolt between the overfender and the stock fender (Fig 2 and Fig 3).
- From the backside of the stock fender, place a fender washer (9) and nylock nut (10) on the bolt loosely. You will need space and flexibility to install all the spacers (Fig. 3).
- Install the shorter bolts (2) with washers (7) on the vertical seam. These bolts do not need spacers. Install a fender washer (9) and nylock nut (10) as described in step 6.
- 8. Repeat steps 2 through 7 to install the other three overfenders.
- Tighten bolts hand tight so that the parts are snug. NOTICE: The plastic could be damaged by over tightening.

MAINTENANCE:

Check and adjust as necessary.

CARE AND CLEANING:

Wash with a mild soap and water solution using a soft cloth. Using Yamacoat[™] spray (ACC-YAMAC-OA-TC), available from your Yamaha dealer, will help keep the overfenders and other plastics easy to clean and looking new.
